# What is Title I-A?

- ⊙ Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are at most risk of falling behind.
- ⊙ Title I funds are allocated to schools based on the percentage of students receiving free/reduced lunch.
- ⊙ Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a Title IA schoolwide program.

# Salem Keizer Public School District

In 2022-2023 Salem Keizer School District will support:

- ⊙ 4 Title I-A Preschools
- ⊙ 24 Title I-A Elementary Schools
- ⊙ 6 Title I-A Middle Schools
- ⊙ 3 Title I-A High Schools
- ⊙ 10 Title I-A Private Schools

This is approximately 17,416 students or 49% of the total student population in the district.

## To be a Schoolwide Title I-A School:

- ⊙ The school must have a free/reduced lunch count of at least 40%.
- ⊙ The school must collect and analyze data that affects student achievement
- ⊙ The school must develop a continuous improvement plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan
- ⊙ ALL Title I-A schools in Salem Keizer are Schoolwide Programs.

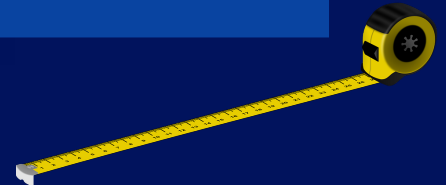

  - \* EasyCBM tells who is on target to meet grade level benchmarks by the end of the school year
